Return of Solano Avenue Stroll a Triumph: 150,000+ people visited Solano Avenue for the 2022 Solano Avenue Stroll after a two-year hibernation. We wish to acknowledge the Albany and Berkeley City Council(s), the Cities of Albany and Berkeley, Albany Subaru, Mechanics Bank, Pivot Point Commuter Hubs, Waste Management, and Andronico's Community Markets.

Jennifer Hansen-Romero and the Albany City Council: Jennifer has replaced Ge'Nell Geary on the Albany City Council through 2024! To avoid any appearance of conflict of interest, Jennifer has stepped-down from the Solano Avenue Association Board of Directors. Long-time Vice President Jason Bellevue has stepped up as President.

Quarterly Printed Newsletter: In October the SAA printed and hand-distributed a single page update about SAA current events, policy adjustments, and more. We hope you found this helpful and informative. We are planning to continue this effort.

Stroll-ish Seasonal Events a Success: Thanks to our Platinum Sponsors including the City of Albany, Gordo's Taqueria, Waste management, and the Berkeley-Solano Avenue Business Improvement District. The SAA highly encourages businesses to plan their events on Stroll-ish days whenever convenient – we are all in this together!

Reduction in Member Dues: In early 2022 when the SAA Board was making plans to survive a third year without its major source of revenue, the decision was made to significantly increase membership dues. Without the Stroll the Board saw this as the only way to keep the organization solvent and active. Of course we were able to hold a 2022 Stroll, and all signs indicate full steam ahead going forward. In light of that, the Board is reducing the base membership dues this year to \$288, down from \$335. While still an increase from the 2021 dues, we believe this is the right rate with our much-expanded program and all around increased costs. As always, if this rate poses a difficulty for your business, we are always happy to work with you.

SAA Programs

The **Solano Avenue gift card program** continues to bring thousands of dollars of business to the Avenue each year. Every gift card that is sold is \$10 that must be spent at a Solano Avenue business.

- Our active **social media presence** reminds our neighbors of what Solano has to offer. The SAA is hiring a **professional Social Media manager** to step up our game and help us promote the Avenue!
- SAA staff and our Board President continue to meet quarterly with staff
 of both Albany and Berkeley to discuss maintenance issues and
 to advocate for improvements. Our frequent eyes on the street are
 invaluable for alerting the cities to immediate problems, and longer term
 issues.
- The **Blue Glove Crew** continues to clean up the street three days a week, rain or shine as it has for nearly 15 years! All are welcome to join. They meet on Solano at the BART tracks M, W, F at 7:50am.


